Offerings or donations can be made in several ways including:-

OPEN PLATE

Before and after the Sunday services there is an opportunity to make a financial gift. The offering plate sits at the entrance to the sanctuary.

WEEKLY FREEWILL OFFERING ENVELOPES (WFO)

These envelopes are used to assist regular giving and are generally placed in the offering plate whilst attending Sunday services. Money gifted via this means can be 'Gift Aided.' Further information regarding this method of giving can be had from our Session Clerk, Gail Alexander.

STANDING ORDER

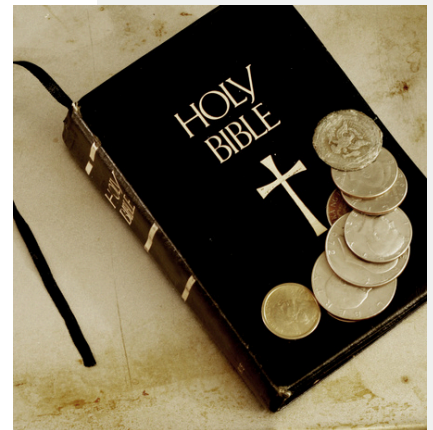

Gift Aid

If you give by WFO or Standing Order and are a tax payer, we can claim 25p back on every pound that you give via the government Gift Aid scheme. Simply complete a Gift Aid Declaration which you can obtain from Gail Alexander. It can be cancelled at any time should your circumstances change.
